Important Notes:

- a) **Evaluation Criteria:** Your prices should be competitive. Award will be made to the "lowest priced technically acceptable offer". The U.S. Government reserves the right to reject an offer which is priced too high or too low.
- b) **Payment terms:** There's no provision for any advance payment. Award will be issued through a US Government purchase order. Payment shall be made through EFT within 30 days from the date of receipt of a proper invoice, or the vehicles have been accepted, whichever is later.
- c) **Terms & Conditions:** The purchase shall be bound by the FAR & DOSAR Clauses as attached. Upon request, the Contracting Officer will make their full text available. - d) **Validity of offer:** Your offer should be valid for at least 90 days from the submission date. Once the Purchase Order is awarded the prices shall hold good until the order is 100% fulfilled.
- e) **Taxes:** The US Consulate General is exempt from all taxes, include the excise tax. Appropriate documents for excise exemption would be done and sent to the dealer/manufacturer and VAT/GST exemption certificate, as applicable, would be provided against the invoice.
