CHENNAI: The Study in the U.S. - EducationUSA University Fair 2019 is being held in Chennai as part of the annual all-India tour August 31 to September 12, including stops in Mumbai, New Delhi, Kolkata, Hyderabad, Kochi, Chennai, Bengaluru, Hubli, Ahmedabad, and Changa. In Chennai, the fair will be held on Saturday, September 7, 2019 from 2:15 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Hotel Hyatt Regency, Teynampet, Chennai 600018.

The 41 participating U.S. universities represent a wide geographic area in the United States and offer a range of academic programs at the undergraduate, graduate, and doctoral levels. Students and their parents can speak with U.S. university representatives about various programs and admission criteria.
