The Consulate General of the United States of America in Mumbai invites you to submit a quotation to provide and replace roll up mosquito screens with motorized rolled up screen. This should be up to 10 feet from the ground level. The remaining top portion should be 12 feet fixed and stainless steel/fibre screens.

The U.S. Government intends to award a purchase order to the responsible company submitting an acceptable quotation at the lowest priced, technically acceptable quote. We intend to award the order based on initial quotations, without holding discussions, although we may hold discussions with companies in the competitive range if there is a need to do so.

The RFQ does not commit the U.S. Consulate General, Mumbai to make any award. The Consulate may cancel this RFQ or any part of it.

The U.S. Consulate General, Mumbai intends to conduct a site visit on April 12, 2023, at 11.00 a.m. (IST) at the U.S. Consulate General Mumbai. Prospective offerors/quoters should contact Mumbaicontracts@state.gov by 11.00 a.m. (IST) on April 11, 2023, for additional information or to arrange entry to the building.

Proposals are due by 4.00 p.m. (IST) on April 20, 2023. No proposals will be accepted after this time. Proposals must be in English and incomplete proposals will not be accepted.

Proposal must be submitted vis email marked "Proposal for Motorized rolled up mosquito screens" and the Solicitation number PR11545602 to the attention of the Contracting Officer, through MumbaiContracts@state.gov


In order for a proposal to be considered, you must also complete and submit the following:
